HOW TO SELECT/HIGHLIGHT



HOW TO SELECT/HIGHLIGHT TEXT IS SELECTED WHEN HIGHLIGHTED

SELECTING ONE CHARACTER:

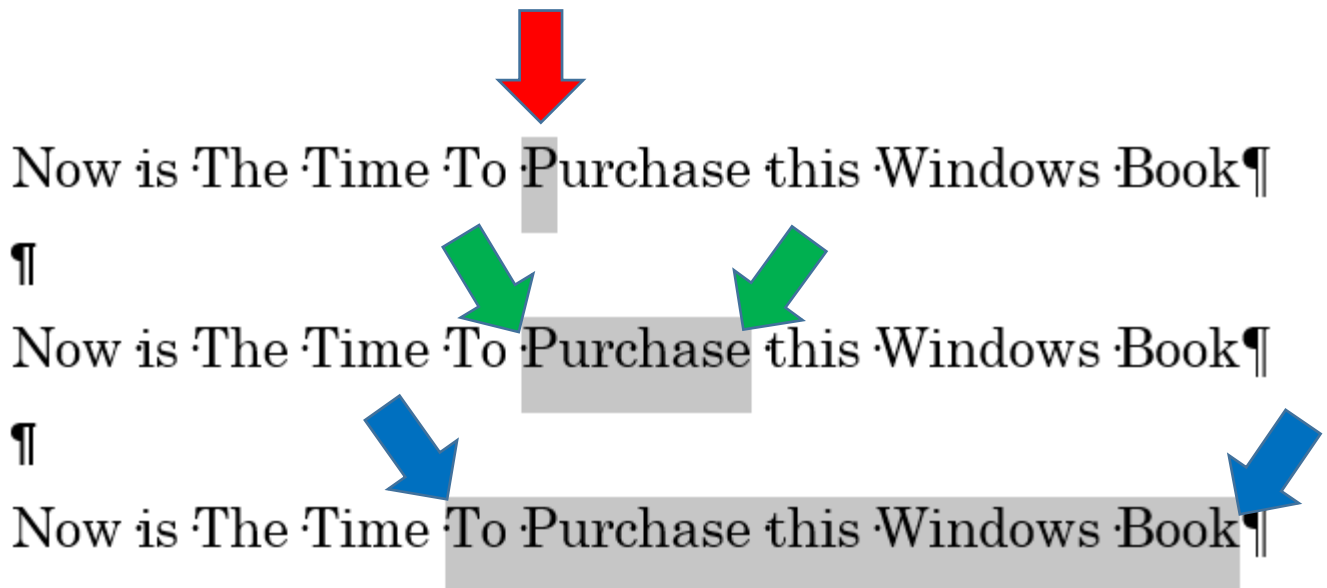
Place cursor on text to “Select” (**red** arrow below). *Hold Down Left Click* and *Drag* over text to highlight (**red** arrow below), *Release Mouse*.

SELECTING ONE WORD:

Place cursor on the beginning or the end of the text to “Select” (**green** arrows below). *Hold Down Left Click* and *Drag* over word to highlight (**green** arrows below), *Release Mouse*.

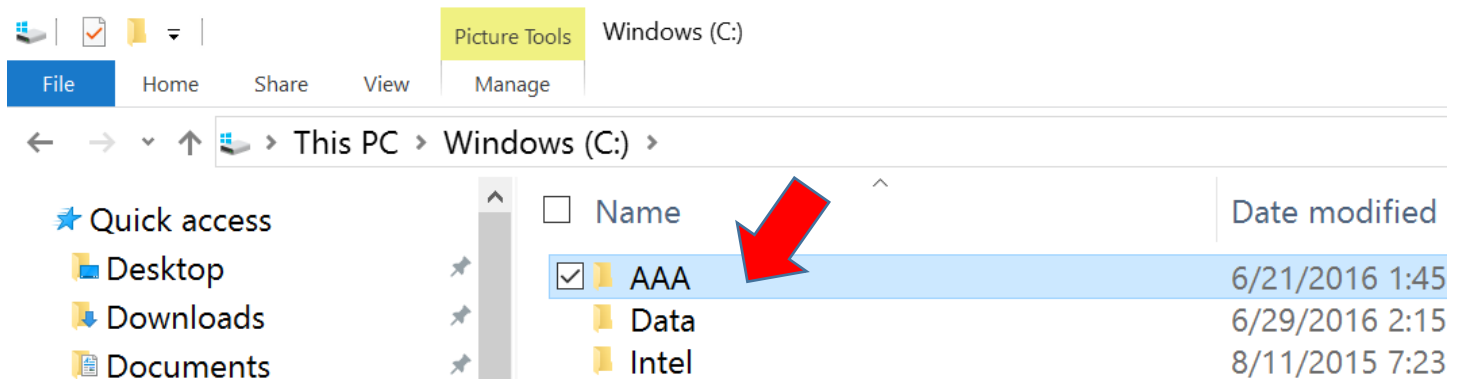
SELECTING A SENTENCE, GROUP OR PARAGRAPH OF TEXT:

Place cursor on the beginning or the end of the text to “Select” (**blue** arrows below). *Hold Down Left Click* and *Drag* over the text to highlight (**blue** arrows below), *Release Mouse*.

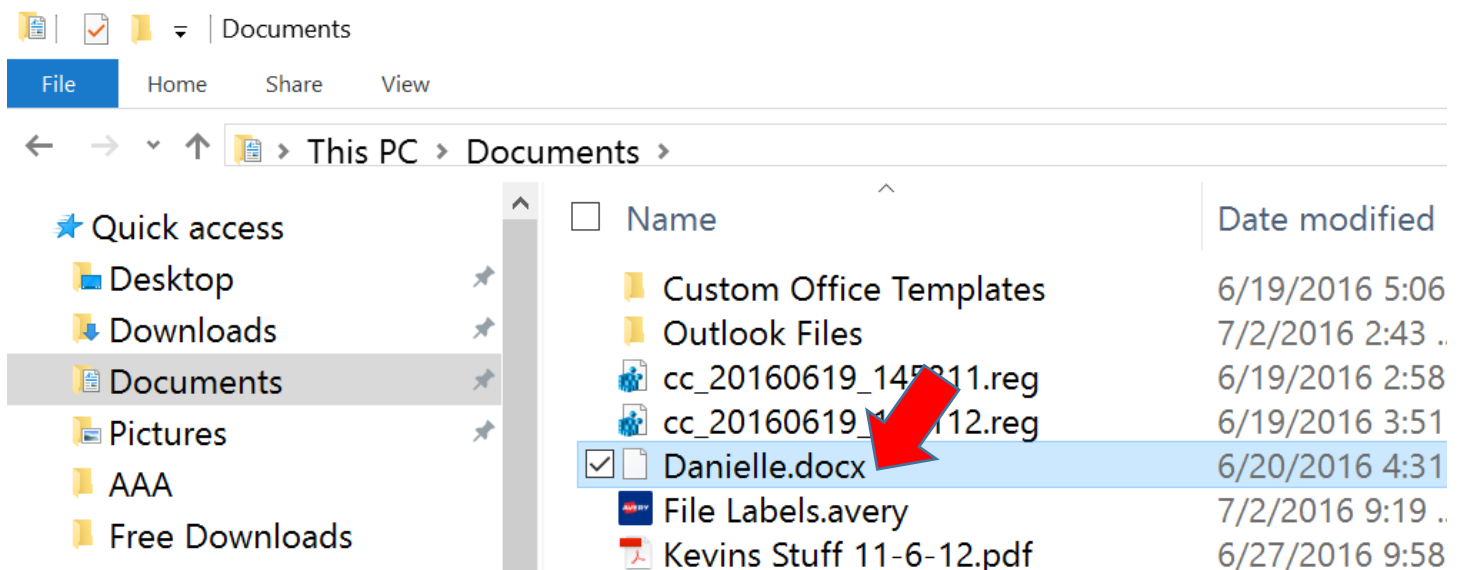


FOLDERS/FILES ARE SELECTED WHEN HIGHLIGHTED

Below “AAA Folder” was *Left Clicked* (red arrow below) to *Highlight*.



Below the file “Danielle.docx” was *Left Clicked* (red arrow below) to *Highlight*.



MULTIPLE FILES/FOLDERS

To Select/Highlight multiples files/folders, select one file or folder *Hold Down* the “Ctrl key” and select another file/folder. Immediately *Release* “Ctrl key”. Repeat as needed.
