ACCESS INTERNET



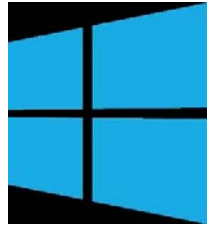
If connected, skip this section.

Internet Provider: Wi-Fi or Wired connection. See *Chapter 3 How To Connect To Wi-Fi in the Windows 10 Manual*. No WiFi, then plug in with a wired connection using an Ethernet cable. See *Chapter 3 How To Connect If No Wi-Fi in the Windows 10 Manual*.

MICROSOFT ACCOUNT.



Recommend signing in using a Microsoft Account. Using the Microsoft Store, OneDrive, and Synchronizing all require a Microsoft account. For more information, download *How To Create A Microsoft Account* (free download) or use the following method:

Left Click “Start” (Windows Logo) > Left Click “Settings” > Left Click “Accounts” > Left Click “Sign-in options” > Left Click “Sign in with a Microsoft account instead” > . Follow directions to create or sign in with a Microsoft Account. “No account? Create one”.

DOWNLOAD WINDOWS 10 UPDATES



Do not Web surf unless the computer is fully up-to-date. How long the computer sat on the shelf will determine how long this takes. See *Chapter 19, Download Windows 10 Updates in the Windows 10 Manual*. Repeat the procedure until no new updates are available.

SETUP EDGE



Microsoft's new browser, Edge replaced Internet Explorer. Configure below to use effectively.

UTILITY

CCleaner (free at piriform.com). A utility that cleans out the 'junk' that accumulates over time: temporary files, broken shortcuts, and helps protect your privacy.

EMAIL, CALENDAR & CONTACTS



Windows 10 has a built in Mail, Calendar, and People App. Email though available through your Browser, these apps are a smart choice. Once set up, with a single mouse click access to all your email accounts are in one location. Also all contacts and calendar can be synchronized with other devices.
